GRAND MASTER'S MESSAGE



GREGORY C. POWELL Grand Master

We Came", has been a particular interest of mine ever since I became a "KEN-TUCKY FREEMA-SON." I had the pleasure of attending the Grand Lodge of Virginia, A.F.&A.M. in November of 2006 as the Grand Master of Kentucky accompanied by my

wife, Nancy, who just so happens to be of Virginia heritage. This event will forever be enshrined in our memory as one of the most monumental events in our lives.

Our Grand Lodge was set to work by the Grand Lodge of Virginia back in 1800 and I would like to take a moment and look back at the five founding lodges that were instrumental in forming our Grand Lodge.

The first lodge founded in Kentucky was Lexington Lodge No. 25 chartered November 17, 1788. The three founding brothers were Richard Clough Anderson, the first Master of Lexington #25 and a captain in the Virginia Continentals during the Revolution and crossed the Delaware in the first boat at the Battle of Trenton in 1776. Green Clay, presented the petition of the Kentucky Masons to the Grand Lodge of Virginia and was a cousin of Henry Clay. John Fowler, served as Master of Lexington #25 in 1790 and was also elected to Congress.

The second lodge founded in Kentucky was Paris Lodge No. 35 chartered October 28, 1791. Horatio Hall was the first Master, John Waller the first Senior Warden, and James Lanair the first Junior Warden. Both brothers' Hall and Waller served in the Kentucky Legislature.

Georgetown Lodge No. 46 then became the third lodge founded in Kentucky and was chartered on November 29, 1796. They were the first lodge chartered in Kentucky after statehood was attained in 1792. The

"From Whence first officers were William Sutton - Master, Parker Calhoun - Senior Warden and John Hunter - Junior Warden. Brother Hunter was a member of the Kentucky House of Representatives.

The fourth Kentucky lodge was established at our State Capital, Frankfort, as Frankfort Hiram Lodge No. 57 and was given a dispensation May 22, 1797. Daniel Weisiger, Thomas Todd, and Baker Ewing were the first primary officers for a lodge in Frankfort, "Kentuckee" according to the Grand Lodge of Virginia Dispensation. After some delay, a charter was issued on December 11, 1799. Master Weisiger was associated with laying of the city of Frankfort in 1787 and was one of the commissioners entrusted with the construction of the Kentucky State House in 1814. Brother Todd was a Clerk of the conventions that led to the statehood for Kentucky. He was also appointed by President Thomas Jefferson to the United States Supreme Court in 1807. Brother Ewing served as the first Register of the Land Office of Kentucky in 1792 and was also a member of the Kentucky House of Representatives in 1802.

The final lodge organized in Kentucky prior to the founding of our Grand Lodge was Abraham, U.D. on July 10, 1800 and had Simon Adams, Master and James Wardlaw, Senior Warden as representatives at the founding of the Grand Lodge of Kentucky.

So in 1800, the Grand Lodge of Kentucky, the first Grand Lodge organized in the United States in the nineteenth century, the first west of the Appalachian Mountains, and the twelfth Grand Lodge in the then-existing sixteen states, would come into being.

This is just a small excerpt of our rich and prestigious Masonic history within the Commonwealth of Kentucky and you can find more in the publication available at our Grand Lodge Office entitled, Kentucky Freemasonry 1788-1978, The Grand Lodge and The Men Who Made It. BE PROUD KENTUCKY MASON!!!





This past December the 38th President of the United States of America, Brother Gerald Rudolph Ford, made a celestial journey "To that undiscovered country from whose bourn no traveler returns". He is the last Masonic President to have served in that office since his tenure from 1974 to 1977, joining such notable Masonic Presidents as George Washington, Harry S. Truman, Franklin D. Roosevelt, Andrew Jackson, Theodore Roosevelt, Warren Harding and seventeen others. Brother Ford was sworn into the office at a critical time in our nation's history, and carried it through that tragic period, exhibiting integrity, compassion, courage and leadership all the while. No doubt, Brother Ford drew upon his knowledge of the Masonic virtues and tenets he was taught throughout his Masonic career. And they were aptly demonstrated in the manner in which he carried out the duties of President, and in the individual character he expressed in dealing with his fellow beings.

On February 17, 1975, he expressed his feeling about the Masonic Fraternity in these words: "Masonic principles—internal, not external—and our Order's vision of duty to country and acceptance of God as a Supreme Being and guiding light have sustained me during my years of Government service. Today especially, the guidelines by which I strive to become an upright man in Masonry give me great personal strength". This expression serves as undisputable evidence that Freemasonry played an important part in the life, character and style of Brother Ford. His Masonic history is no less extensive. He was Initiated in Malta Lodge No. 465 (Michigan) on September 30, 1949, and Raised to the Sublime Degree of Master Mason on May 18, 1951, in Columbia Lodge No. 3 (Washington, D.C.) as a courtesy to Malta Lodge. He was a member of the Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite, Northern Jurisdiction, Sovereign Grand Inspector General Honorary of the 33°, and Honorary member of the Supreme Council. He was an Active Member of the Supreme Council of the International Order of DeMolay, and Honorary Grand Master of the Order; these along with numerous hon-
