As I sat to write this article, I received a phone call from a Brother Secretary in Eastern Kentucky with information of the passing of a fellow Secretary who served his lodge in that capacity for over sixty years. Brother William Lewis Baldridge, Jr. was Raised to the Sublime Degree of Master Mason in East Point Lodge No. 657, F.&A.M. on May 4, 1946, and elected Secretary of the lodge in December of that same year. Except for a short period during which he progressed through the officers' line in East Point Lodge, serving as Master in 1959, he continued to serve as Secretary until his death on February 8, 2008. That equates to sixty two continuous years of service in office, a credit to his lodge and the Fraternity. I have no knowledge of anyone coming close to matching that record of continually serving as a lodge officer for that length of time. East Point Lodge No. 657, and Kentucky Freemasonry, has lost a true and valuable servant in the passing of Brother Baldridge-but the Grand Architect of the Universe will surely profit by his presence; May he rest in peace and enjoy the rewards he so richly deserves "that house not made with hands, eternally in the Heavens".

LOST A MASONIC RING?

A Masonic ring was turned in to the Grand Lodge Office recently by a Brother who found it in the Galt House. It may have been lost by a Brother attending Grand Lodge during the Annual Communication. If you think it may be your ring, you may retrieve the same by calling the Grand Lodge Office (502-893-0192) and giving an accurate description of the ring; in which case, you may either pick the ring up at the Grand Lodge Office, or have it mailed to you on request.

MASONIC DIRECTORY

Lodge Secretaries, you should soon receive a Masonic Directory for your use. Additional Directories may be purchased from the Grand Lodge Office at cost plus mailing charges.

Again this year several Lodges that failed to submit the list of Officers elected and appointed will not be listed in the Directory, and several others were late in submitting the list. This oversight on the part of those Lodges makes the Directory late in completion and less useful to those who may wish to visit or contact those Lodges not listed than it would be otherwise.

Each year it is my hope that we can have all Lodges report the newly elected and appointed Officers prior to January 10 and have 100% of the Lodges included in the Directory. Again, this year we didn't make it-- Maybe next year!!!

You should carefully review this report and compare it with your records and report any discrepancies to the Grand Lodge Office immediately. It is very important that our records match your Lodges records, so please review this report in detail.

Technology allows more one-on-one time

This year, nursing staff at the Masonic Home of Louisville are spending less time at a desk and more time with residents.

Smart Charting, an electronic resident data management system, gives nursing and management staff up-to-the minute information on the status of each resident.

Voluminous paper files that contained resident information — and the staff time spent documenting changes by hand — have been replaced by 23 Smart Charting kiosks mounted in work and nurse stations.

Up-to-the-minute resident data — from vital signs and dining habits to overall progress — is available to nursing staff on the secured system. Resident issues can be addressed quickly and discussed by line staff and managers by phone, since all resident information can be viewed on the kiosks and Smart Chart computers.

Director of Nursing Bill Grenier said staff has adapted well to the new system and are getting comfortable with the technology. "At the end of the day, there used to be several nurses filling in charts," Grenier said. "Now more time is spent with our residents."


