



Cindy, and the Masonic Homes together, will be having several programs throughout the year to promote this worthwhile endeavor. Annually it costs approximately \$1,000,000 to provide Masonicare to currently 41 patients at the Masonic Homes of Kentucky. This year, I ask that you join me in RENEWING OUR OBLIGATION, *obligations* that were not put in

place by me. They are a part of the original foundation that our age-old fraternity was built upon. Please renew your obligations and donate to Masonic C.A.R.E. in support of the Masonic Homes of Kentucky residents to assist in providing for their well-being. ALL net proceeds from the different programs (pins, etc...) that we will have will go 100% towards Masonicare.

This year a Masonic Archives Committee has been established to start the process of organizing and categorizing the Grand Lodge of Kentucky Library and Museum at the Grand Lodge Office. We will need the Craft of Kentucky's help with this. This year the net proceeds from the Annual Holiday Cards that you will be receiving soon will be designated for improving and maintaining this Library and Museum. Please consider donating as liberally as you can without detriment to yourselves to ensure that our Masonic History is secure forever.

All Veterans are special and I especially feel that Kentucky Veterans deserve respect and honor across this Commonwealth. Therefore, I have re-establish a Veterans Committee this year. 

## **Satisfying customers earns Louisville and Shelbyville Homes national honors**

The Pillars Assisted Care Center at Masonic Home of Louisville was awarded 2012 Highest Honors from Holleran, a firm which helps non-profit organizations better understand their customers.
