Alexandria Lodge 152 Baby Emersyn's Fundraiser



Reach Out for Kosair Kids® A FUNDRAISER FOR KOSAIR CHARITIES



H.A.M. Henderson Lodge No. 515 presented a check in the amount of \$1,000 to Reach Out for Kosair Kids® with a little help from a Kosair Clown.

The Glasgow Shrine Club and Willie 94.1 (WLYE-FM), both located in Glasgow, Kentucky, team up to host their annual Kosair Charities fundraising event, Reach Out for Kosair Kids®, at the Cave City Convention Center. Over \$24,600 was raised for Kosair Charities at the third event held on Saturday, August 2nd, 2014.

Kosair Charities, located in Louisville, is the largest children's charity in the region. For more information on Kosair Charities, go to www.kosair.org.

Growing from 300 people in 2012 to more than 1,000 attending in 2014, the Reach Out for Kosair Kids® event has no admission fee and kids' activities are free. This day is filled with fun for the entire family. Face painting, inflatables (bouncy houses), a cake walk, scavenger hunt, mascots, karaoke, and a Hearts for Kids game gives the kids plenty to do. The adults enjoy a motorcycle bug run, antique tractor and car show, karaoke, a live auction, a silent auction and the Zaxby's wing eating contest, the "Wing Chomp."

The live auction is the biggest part of the event. For the past three years, a quilt has been made to honor our Kosair Kids®. The names of Kosair Kids® are stitched onto the quilts and efforts are made to ensure there are no repeat names from previ-

ous years. The first quilt in 2012 had the names of 65 Kosair Kids® and sold at auction for \$3,200. This quilt now hangs in the office of Kosair Charities in Louisville. The 2014 quilt had the names of 84 Kosair Kids® stitched around the boots and was purchased for \$1,250 by the family of one of the 2014 Kosair Kids®. All three quilts have been made by Janice and Gleta Stalcup of J C & G Embroidery in Burkesville, Kentucky.

The Glasgow Shrine Club serves the counties of Barren, Allen, Hart, Metcalfe and Monroe. Area businesses and individuals donated auction items or make monetary donations to the event.

Each year more of our Masonic Lodges and individual members are making monetary contributions for the kids' prizes. Tompkinsville Lodge #753, Acme Lodge #851, Austin Lodge #847, and Brother Ken Lane of Allen Lodge #24 have made monetary donations for the kids' prizes each year since the 2013 event.

Two Masonic lodges from the area made monetary donations at the 2014 Reach Out for Kosair Kids®. H.A.M. Henderson #515 (pictured) presented a check in the amount of \$1,000 and Hi-seville #787 donated \$500.

Allen Lodge #24 has furnished 40 dash plaques for all three of the antique tractor and car shows.

The Reach Out for Kosair Kids® event would not happen if it were not for the many volunteers who help with the event preparations and with the day's activities. The number of Masonic Brothers who volunteer to help continues to grow – some even bring family members along to help. We were fortunate to have the members of the Lincoln DeMolay Chapter and the Mt. Washington Rainbow Assembly to help with the kids' activities in 2014 and they will be returning in 2015.

The Reach Out for Kosair Kids® event has raised \$61,700 for Kosair Charities since 2012.

The 2015 event will be held on August 1st at the Cave City Convention Center in Cave City, Kentucky. The parade will begin at 8:30 (CDT) and the activities open at 9 a.m. (CDT). Plans to

make this 2015 Reach Out for Kosair Kids® event even bigger and better have already begun. Added for 2015 will be mini-cheerleading and basketball clinics for kids ages 12 and under, a dunkin' booth, and basketball competitions for all ages.

Mr. Clarence Glover, a former NBA player with the Boston Celtics and a member of the 1971 WKU Final Four basketball team, will be conducting the basketball clinic. He is a native of Horse Cave, Kentucky, and a graduate of Caverna High School.






