"I Didn't Know That....."

The Society of Blue Friars, founded in 1932, was formed to recognize worthy authors and researchers for their contributions to the understanding of the historical philosophy and purpose of Freemasonry.

Over the years, Blue Friars have included such illustrious Masonic writers as Ray V. Denslow, Carl H. Claudy, Henry W. Coil, Dwight L. Smith, Thomas W. Jackson and S. Brent Morris.

Until this year, Kentucky has had only one Blue Friar, Brother Charles Snow Guthrie (1922 – 2000), who wrote, *Kentucky Freemasonry 1788 – 1978: The Grand Lodge and the Men Who Made It*. W. B. Guthrie was named a Blue Friar in 1993.

On February 9, 2024, during Masonic Week in Washington, D. C., Grand Abbott Arturo de Hoyos announced that noted Kentucky author, researcher and Freemason John W. Bizzack has been named as the newest Blue Friar. In the 92 history of the organization, W. B. Bizzack is the 111th Blue Friar.

W. B. Bizzack is a forty-five-year veteran in the field of policing and criminal justice. He served over half of his criminal justice career with the Lexington (KY) Police Department. He rose through the ranks serving most of his career in the Criminal Investigation Bureau, Commander of Special Investigations, Robbery-Homicide, and later the Bureau. He retired in 1996 from assignment in the Office of the Chief of Police.

He was appointed by the governor in three consecutive administrations to the position of Commissioner of the Department of Criminal Justice Training with the Kentucky Justice Cabinet. He retired with twenty years of service where he directed the responsibilities of the department for the hiring and selection practices of Kentucky police officers as well as overseeing certified basic and advanced annual training for over 10,000 law enforcement and criminal justice officials.

A Freemason since 2010, W. B. Bizzack is the author of numerous books, essays, commentaries, and papers on Freemasonry. He was a Co-Producer of the acclaimed documentary, "The Masonic Table." W. B.

Bizzack's books include *Island Freemasonry*, *How and Why Freemasonry Came to Kentucky*, *Notable Men in Kentucky History Who Happened to Be Freemasons*, *The Canker Worm on the Rose*, *Sins of Our Masonic Fathers* and *The Age of Unreason*.

W. B. Bizzack is a member and Past Master of Lexington Lodge No. 1. He has served as a member of the Grand Lodge of Kentucky's Committee on Masonic Education. He is a Fellow and of The Masonic Society and is currently the Second Vice-President of The Philaethes Society. He also serves on the Board of Directors of The Masonic Restoration Foundation. He is Vice-Chair and a Founding Member of The Rubicon Masonic Society. He was named to the initial class of Research

Fellows at William O. Ware Lodge of Research where he is a lifetime member. He is a member of the Scottish Rite (Valley of Louisville), and the Southern California, and Texas Lodges of Research, as well as the Quatuor Coronati Correspondence Circle. He is a member of Fiat Lux Lodge No. 1717, and Alba Lodge No. 222, both in Washington, D.C., and he is an Honorary Member of Sophia Lodge No. 767, North Carolina's first Observant Lodge.

W. B. Bizzack sat as Regent on the board of Eastern Kentucky University and was a co-founder and first President of the Kentucky Law Enforcement Memorial Foundation. He served as Commissioner on the Commission on the Accreditation of Law Enforcement Agencies and Kentucky Crime Council, and various other boards and task forces.

Congratulations to W. B. John W. Bizzack, the newest member of the Society of Blue Friars and the second Kentucky Mason to be so honored!What do you think?
