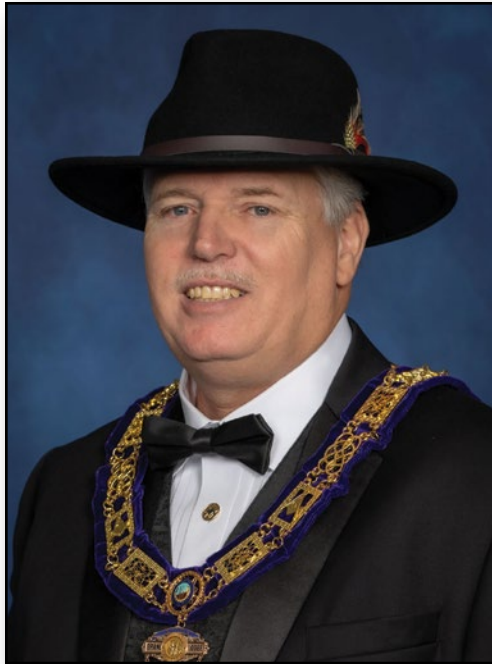

THE APRON & THE EVERGREEN



On March 26, my 41st birthday, my article "A Legacy of Four Generations, and Counting" was published in the April edition of the Kentucky Masonic Home Journal. My father told me he had never taken the time to read the digital edition before, but for whatever reason, he read this one. In a way I could not have known then, it would be the last Masonic Home Journal he ever read.

Afterward, he sent me a message I will carry forever:
"Just read the Masonic Home Journal and could not be more proud of you!!!!
You could be a writer!
It was good!! Made me cry!!!!"

In the early morning hours of April 6th, I received a call I never imagined, my father had passed away unexpectedly from a heart attack at the age of 62.

On April 10th, we honored him with his Masonic rites. Surrounded by my brothers from Temple Hill Lodge #276, I had the honor, as Senior Warden, to present my father with his lambskin apron. My grandfather, serving as Junior Warden, presented the sprig of evergreen. In that moment, I placed my father's white apron upon him, one he will carry for eternity, and instead of placing the evergreen upon the casket, I placed it in his hands.

It was not lost on me what that moment represented: three generations, one watching, two standing together, each honoring our lost father, grandfather, and son.

Later, standing at Dad's casket, my 9-year-old son joined me and began asking questions. He watched closely that day, the aprons, the service, the meaning behind it all. He told me he wants to be a Mason one day. I told him I would love that, but that I could never ask him, that it must be his choice. He simply nodded.

Maybe the seed has already been planted.

I want to thank my brothers of Temple Hill Lodge #276, and those from across the area who came to pay their respects. Your presence, the Bibles presented to my grandfather and me, and the flowers sent to my mother will never be forgotten.

Freemasonry teaches us about legacy, the quiet influence of good men and the bonds that endure beyond this life. I did not know when I wrote my original article that it would become something more. But I am grateful my father read it, and that he knew what it meant to me.

That is a gift I will carry for the rest of my life.

GRAND HISTORIAN'S NOTES

ALPHEUS EVERETT ORTON

Alpheus Everett Orton was born in Hanson, Hopkins County, Kentucky on February 15, 1875, the son of Edward W. and Anna (Almon) Orton. His grandfather had moved to that vicinity from North Carolina. He spent his early life in Hopkins County engaged in farming. Brother Orton attended the public schools of Hopkins County and graduated from the College of Pharmacy at Louisville in 1896. The year to follow, he clerked in a drug store at Owensboro, and later in Hopkinsville.

Brother Orton, a Deacon of the Christian Church, married Miss Minnie Olden Hamby on December 22, 1897, and took an interest in the civil affairs of his community. Mrs. Orton had been the daughter of W.J. Hamby, who discovered the mineral waters of Dawson Springs on June 7, 1893. While attempting to bore a well to supply his hotel, Mr. Hamby struck an inexhaustible stream capable of supplying 100,000 people a day with water.

Just after their marriage, the Orton's relocated to Evansville, Indiana, where Past Grand Master Orton worked in a wholesale drug house and had charge of the laboratory of both the Evansville Drug Company and Carlstedt Medicine Company until September 1901. They moved back to Dawson Springs later that year. Upon arriving home, he engaged in the mineral water business for several decades. His company shipped water to every state in the union, as well as France, Spain, Canada and Germany. It was claimed that the water from the Hamby Well would cure indigestion, jaundice, constipation, boils, chills, appendicitis, heartburn, torpid liver, nervousness, Blight's Disease, dilation of the stomach, catarrh of the stomach, doudenitis, cystitis, dysentery, neurasthenia, chronic eczema, rheumatism, gout, calculus, female irregularities, nevous and sick headaches, obstructed menstruation, blood disease, dyspepsia, diarrhea, hysteria, malaria, dizziness, dropsy, diabetes, albuminuria, glycosuria, and similar diseases requiring minerals held in suspension such this water.

In addition to the mineral water business, Brother Orton was a director of the New Century Hotel, the Commercial Bank of Dawson, and the Dawson Springs Auditorium Company. Being elected as a Democrat, he served as a member of the Dawson Springs City Council for two terms, as city clerk for two terms, and as city treasurer for 18 years.

He was initiated in Dawson Lodge No. 628 on January 3, 1903, and became Master in 1906, also serving in 1916 and 1917. He received the Capitular Degrees in Madisonville Chapter, later demitting to Dawson Springs Chapter No. 179, Royal Arch Masons, where he served as High Priest. The Grand Chapter of Kentucky, Royal Arch Masons elected and installed Brother Orton as Grand High Priest for 1943-1944. He received the Cryptic Degrees in Princeton Council No. 43, Royal and Select Masters in September 1921, and was knighted in Madisonville Commandery No. 27, Knights Templar in October 1906, later demitting to Princeton Commandery No. 35.

He received the degrees of the Scottish Rite, from the Fourth to the Thirty-Second, in the Grand Consistory of Kentucky at Louisville in

April 1920. Brother Orton was a Past Grand Patron of the Grand Chapter of Kentucky, Order of the Eastern Star (1916-1917), and Mr. And Mrs. Orton were Past Patron and Matron of ws on Springs Chapter (formerly Queen Anne Chapter) No. 133, respectively. He was an ex-officio member of both Homes Boards.

Brother Orton was elected Grand Junior Warden at the 1920 Annual Communication, regularly progressed through the line, and was elected and installed as Grand Master in October 1923.

Brother Orton was a charter member of the George Washington Masonic Association in Washington, D.C.

In 1931 Brother Orton was elected as Potentate of Rizpah Shrine Temple in Madisonville, Kentucky.

He was elected as Grand Secretary at the Annual Communication in October, 1935. Due to the Masonic law in effect at that time, the Grand Secretary was not installed until New Year's Day. Thus, Brother Orton became Grand Secretary on January 1, 1936, and the Orton's moved to Louisville (Mrs. Orton passed away on July 5, 1938).

GRAND HISTORIAN'S NOTES

Brother Orton received his 33rd Degree in the Scottish Rite in October, 1943.

In 1958 the name of Dawson Lodge No. 628 was changed to Al E. Orton Lodge No. 628 in his honor.

Brother Orton served the craft as Grand Secretary of the Grand Lodge of Kentucky for 29 years until his untimely death on the morning of October 17, 1964, at the age of 89.
