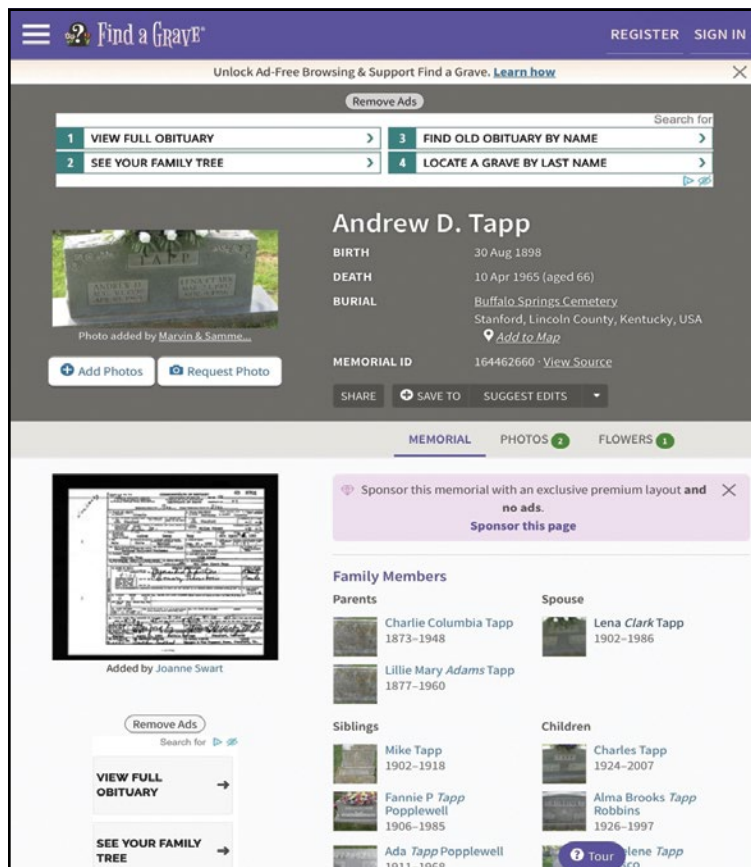
GRAND HISTORIAN'S NOTES

RABBIT HOLE – PART II

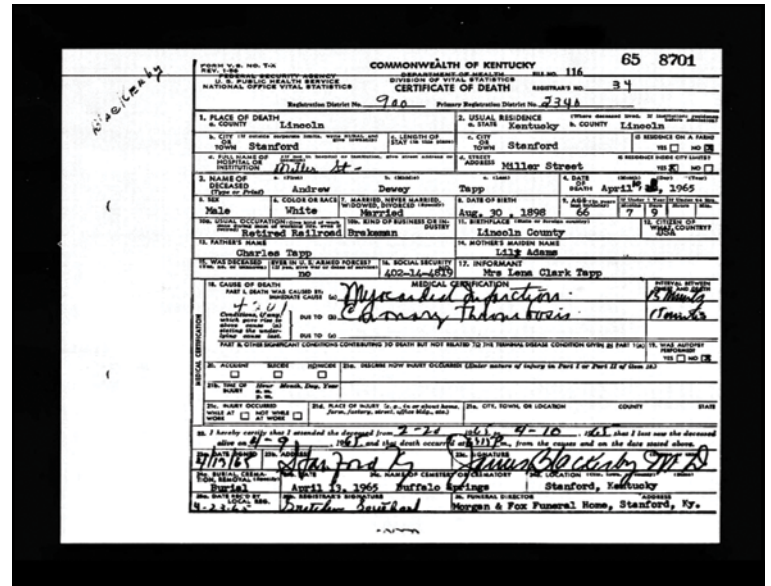
Part 2 will help to show you how to locate that missing ancestor that is a mason. Brother Mike Tapp was the brother that asked me about his great grandfather. First, I went to Find a Grave.



There I found Andrew D. Tapp, Brother Mike's great grandfather.



If you notice, someone has uploaded his death certificate.



From there, I went to the Grand Lodge "Members Only" page. And then to the GL Proceedings tab and clicked on 1965, the year of his death. Doing a search, there I found Andrew A. Tapp (same death date, possibly a typo of the middle initial by the secretary), a member of Lincoln Lodge #60.

Then I went to the Grand Lodge card file and found him there.

You see that on the card there is a lot of information. Sometimes a brother would move a lot and on the back will be information on the lodges that he was a member. Brother Mike told me that the time that his great grandfather was suspended for non-payment of dues (N.P.D.) was probably during the time that the family moved to Ohio for work. That was the depression/post depression era and jobs in rural Kentucky were hard to find. Brother Mike asked what was the name of lodge #731 and where was it located. I checked the list of lodges in the back of the Constitution of the Grand Lodge of Kentucky and found that lodge #731 was Jackson Lodge, later changed to Dave Jackson Lodge #731, located at Livingston in Rockcastle County. Brother Mike was happy to receive this information.

As you can see, it is not very hard to locate your masonic ancestors. This one was not as hard as some.

Happy hunting and don't give up!

To be eligible for election to the office of director, you must be a Kentucky Master Mason. Directors are expected to attend bi-monthly Board meetings every third Wednesday, serve on assigned committees and perform other duties as assigned by the Chair of the Board or Executive Committee. Directors serve without remuneration and must own a Life Membership or Honorary Life Membership (\$250) to Masonic Homes Kentucky. Members are also encouraged to make a contribution to Masonic Homes Kentucky's Masonicare program each year of their service.

To be considered for nomination to the Board of Directors, you must submit a current resume including: name, address, current occupation, phone number, education and work experience, previous board experience, organizational offices held, references and Masonic affiliation and history. The resume may be submitted on regular stationery, mailed with a recent photograph, and postmarked no later than July 1, 2026.
