

To the Master, Wardens and Brothers of the Lodges of the Grand Lodge of Kentucky F&AM:

As Grand Master, I along with the Elected Grand Lodge Officers have been continually monitoring the overall effects of the coronavirus (COVID-19) across the country and more especially in our great Commonwealth. It has been recently reported that Kentucky has suffered it's first death due to the virus. The Governor of Kentucky has taken further steps to minimize the possibility of cross contamination by restricting social gatherings and encouraging social distancing.

In order to do our part as men and Masons to limit the possibility of this virus being transmitted in our lodges and affecting our craft and their families, I have decided that the best action to take now, is to suspend any lodge meetings or lodge activities including degree work in or outside of your lodge for the next 30 days, effective immediately. This will include district meetings thru April 15, 2020. We, the Grand Lodge Officers will continue to re-evaluate the current conditions and, if warranted, make the decision to extend the cancellations.

As a reminder, please continue to see that your lodge responsibilities are performed, such as paying the lodge utility bills, taxes, insurance, etc. and other regular business that can be conducted by the Master, Secretary and Treasurer. Your lodge may still honor a family's request for a Masonic Funeral Service.

We, the Grand Lodge Officers stand ready to help, aid and assist you in any way, including answering any questions you may have. Should the need arise to extend this suspension further, we will make every effort to see that you are promptly notified. During this time, please stay in touch with members, family and friends especially the elderly and those with chronic medical conditions. May the Great Architect of the Universe continue to grant all of us the strength, health and wisdom to see this through.





To all Brethren of the Ancient & Accepted Scottish Rite everywhere, and to all Master Masons in the Jurisdiction of the Valley of Louisville, Orient of Kentucky. The Coronavirus (COVID-19) continues to spread, and the population of our Scottish Rite Masonic Community includes age groups that are particularly susceptible to this virus.

Most organizations have prudently suspended meetings and gatherings in an effort to slow the spread of the virus, and to give our health professionals time to prepare.

On the occasion above, he was attracted to them by watching the lady trying to push her husband in a wheelchair that kept getting stuck in the carpet. He struck up a conversation with them. As it was, he had a used electric wheelchair that he had finished repairing and he offered it to them and even offered to bring it to their home. They declined the offer, but the wife asked for his phone number in the event they changed their mind. A few months later, he received a phone call from the wife. She explained that after the conversation with our Brother, they already had a new electric scooter but they only used it in the house. Not long after that, the husband passed and the now widow had a scooter that was almost brand new. Apparently, the husband had, prior to his passing, requested that the wife try to find a person in need of a scooter and give it to them. She called the Brother and it happened.

The long and short of this story is that a Mason was doing what all brothers should be doing. He met a very nice couple with a need and offered to help. The nice couple remembered this Mason and believed that he could make sure the wishes of the man could be handled. This in fact happened because our Brother believed in what Masonry teaches. “I Didn’t Know That.....”

Most Kentucky Masons are aware that there existed in England, the original London “Modern” Grand Lodge and those who were opposed to some of the changes made by them, and later formed the “Ancient” (Athol) Grand Lodge. Fortunately both Grand Lodges were reunited into the United Grand Lodge of England in 1815. Kentucky used the Ancient’s “Ahiman Rezon”, a book of rules and regulations, to govern their Grand Lodge until they printed their own in 1805. In fact, there were five rival Grand Lodges, the two above (Regular – 1717, and Athol - 1751), plus the “York” – 1725;

Antiquity – 1779; and Scottish (London) – 1770. Only the two of 1717 and 1751 had much influence, or lasted for any length of time. But did you know that there were several other rival organizations in and around London following the institution of first Grand Lodge; viz: the Gormogans, the Gregorians, and the Order of Bucks? The Noble Order of Bucks, considered by many an imitator of the Masons, perhaps was the only ‘friendly’ rival to the London Masons.

The Bucks were a social club, with membership formed of successful young men and noted for their pranks, sometimes extreme. Founded in 1722/23, when Freemasonry was beginning to flourish, they adopted signs and means of recognition, sang songs at their meetings and honored the “Mighty Hunter” Nimrod as their founder, and teacher in architecture. (The Legend of Nimrod and the Tower of Babel, is mentioned throughout the Masonic old manuscripts.)

The Bucks sang, held dances, ate and drank frequently and enjoyed life. They participated in the yearly “Feast of the Turtle” a rare and expensive dinner delicacy of that period, and even made a toast to the Masons at their gatherings. As young men of wealth, looking for a good time, the term ‘buck’ was to become to be understood as a ‘dashing fellow’ or a ‘dandy’. The chorus to one of their songs is as follows:

*Hail to the Fellowship! Hail to the Mirth! Hail to Thee, who gave them birth!
Hail great Nimrod! Pow’r Divine! Hunters Patron! God of Wine!
Thee we sing, in Jovial Lays, We thy Godlike, action praise;
Hail to Thee, thou Pow’r divine! Jolly Bacchus! God of Wine!
Masons praise thee for the Art, Which thou didst to them impart!*

(The Mason’s ‘Art’ as above, is that of “conversing without speaking”, the ability to tell a Mason from another, by signs, words, and tokens).

Fortunately their minutes, rules, ceremonies and other documents and songs have been preserved, so that we are able to learn much about them instead of relying simple newspaper clips. Their obligation, administered by the ‘Noble Grand’ states the purpose of membership, “but your chief aim in the Lodge, shall be to promote Good-fellowship, Freedom of conversation, Innocent Mirth, and every social Virtue as a Good Companion”. Their mottos: “Unanimity is the strength of the Society. Be Merry and Wise. Freedom with Innocence. Industry produces Wealth.”

The fact that the “Bucks” met in taverns, sang at dinner, made toasts, had their signs and words, which caused many outsiders to believe the Freemasons and the Noble Order of the Bucks were parallel societies.
