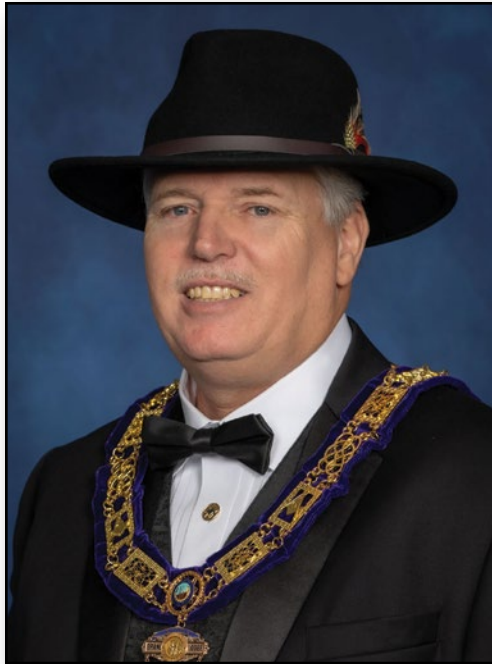

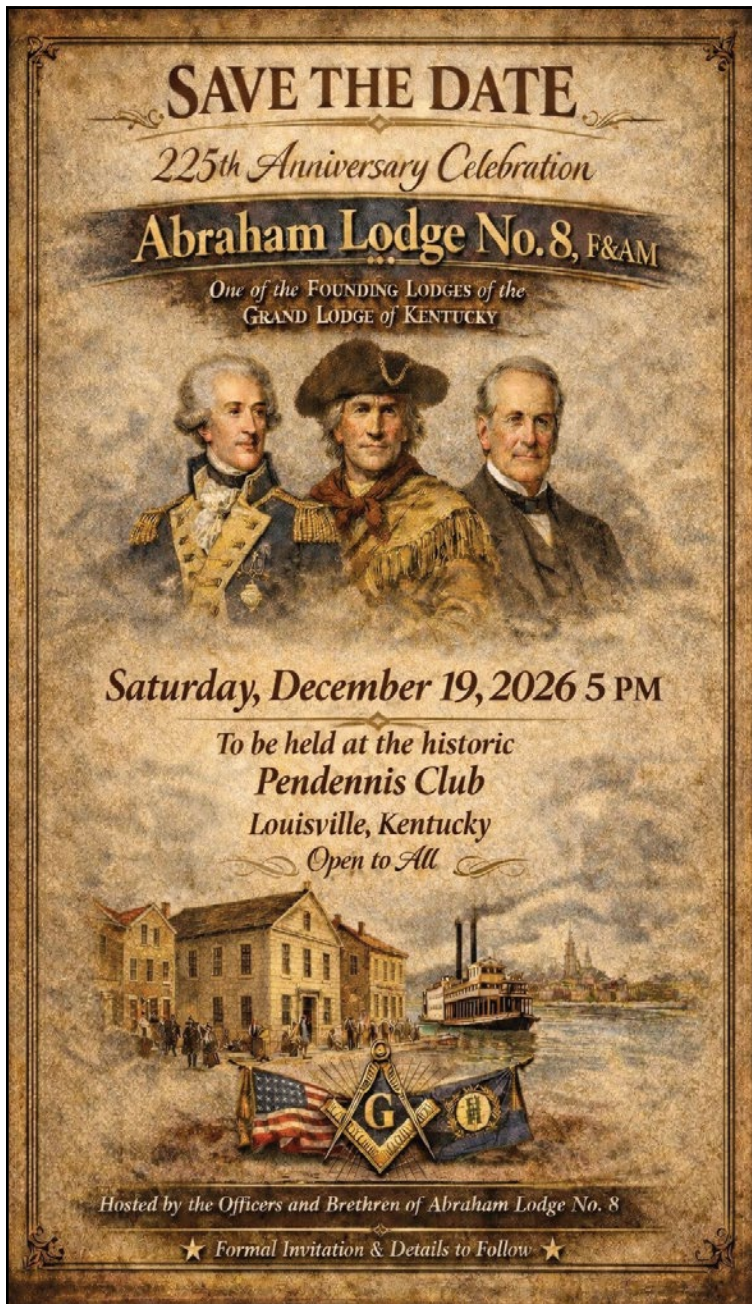

GRAND HISTORIAN'S NOTES

THE MASONIC RABBIT HOLE

I have been asked many times, "Brother Bill, I know my great-grandfather was a Mason, but how do I find out where he was a member?" This is a lot like genealogy research, and you may find more than you bargain for; so be prepared to "Go down the rabbit hole". I recommend keeping a pen and paper beside you when you start this search, because there will be many distracting finds that could lead you astray. You can chase those "rabbits" later.

If all you have is the name of the person you are looking for, you will need a starting point. I like to start with findagrave.com. Here you can enter all the information that you have. This should give you the birth date, death date, where he is buried, and maybe a full name and other family members, provided someone has entered the information on the website.

With his year of death, you can now go to glky.org, the Grand Lodge of Kentucky website. Go to the "MEMBERS ONLY SECTION" at the top of the page. It is very easy to register your membership here if you have not already. You MUST register to use the site. In the left column, click on the "GL Proceedings" (Grand Lodge Proceedings). Here you will find all the Grand Lodge Proceedings since 1800. Find the death year of the person you are looking for and clicking on the corresponding year of GL Proceedings.

Depending on the month of his passing, you may need to look in the next year's GL Proceedings. At the top right of the page, you will find a search box with a magnifying glass. Type in the person's last name here and click on the magnifying glass. Every page in the proceedings where that name appears will be listed on the left side of the screen. If there are many entries of the name found, the list may be long and you may have to scroll down to see them all. You can search by clicking on each page and your name will be highlighted in yellow. Once you find the person that you are looking for, just right-click to print the page. Follow the prompts to print the page(s) that you want.

Prior to the Grand Lodge of Kentucky database, 2005, the names of members were kept in a card file at the Grand Lodge office. The card file is still at the Grand Lodge office for anyone to see. On these cards, you will find the members' birth name; their E.A., F.C. and M.M. dates; affiliations with other lodges, death date and other information.

If all else fails, you can email the Grand Lodge office at jamie@glky.org and they will search the card file for you, as time permits.

Seeking Nominations

The Annual Meeting of Masonic Homes Kentucky will be held on Monday, Oct. 19, 2026. Five Directors will be elected to serve a three-year term.

To be eligible for election to the office of director, you must be a Kentucky Master Mason. Directors are expected to attend bi-monthly Board meetings every third Wednesday, serve on assigned committees and perform other duties as assigned by the Chair of the Board or Executive Committee. Directors serve without remuneration and must own a Life Membership or Honorary Life Membership (\$250) to Masonic Homes Kentucky. Members are also encouraged to make a contribution to Masonic Homes Kentucky's Masonicare program each year of their service.

To be considered for nomination to the Board of Directors, you must submit a current resume including: name, address, current occupation, phone number, education and work experience, previous board experience, organizational offices held, references and Masonic affiliation and history.
